KWPN-NA Education and Judging Seminar at Prima Equestrian on September 22, 2009

Every year, people contact the KWPN-NA office regarding the keuring judging process. Questions range from “What is it?”, “How does it work?”, “How is it different from other Warmblood inspections?” to “What are they looking for?”

The KWPN-NA has formalized the answers to these questions, and much more, in the KWPN Education Seminars. The seminars will be held during the keuring tour at designated locations with a focus on geographic coverage.

This year two seminars will be held: Claybrook Farm (MI) and Prima Equestrian (ON). Prima Equestrian is pleased to host the first KWPN-NA Education Seminar to be held in Canada at our farm in Mount Albert, Ontario on September 22, 2009.

The seminars will be conducted the day before each of these keuringen. The format will include both lectures and hands-on experience, explaining the KWPN system, what it is that the jury looks for in each particular type of horse and why the horses are scored the way they and includes movement/jumping class specifications and rules. Participants will be introduced to KWPN history, purpose and use of the linear score sheet as well as sport-conformation review and pedigree concerns. By the end of the seminar participants will be expected to complete a linear score sheet, assign scores and verbalize their conclusions to the group. Lunch is included.
