# Frozen Semen Breeding Contract

for breeding of the "Mare" \_\_\_\_\_ to VDL Stud frozen  
semen by the stallion Chin Chin. This contract is subject to the following terms and  
conditions:

## TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- This contract covers each purchase of a VDL Stud Frozen Semen breeding for 1 foal only from the stallion Chin Chin. Semen will be sent one dose at a time, up a total of 3 doses. If the mare is not in foal after 3 doses have been used over 3 different breeding cycles, the buyer has the option of switching to Navarone or Farrington standing at Majestic Gaits in Brookline, NH, USA using fresh semen with a live foal guarantee. Each dose will contain the correct amount of straws required for each breeding dose as determined by VDL Stud in Holland. The number of straws required is provided to you when your Frozen Semen is shipped to you.
- The buyer must notify Prima Equestrian if they plan on using embryo transfer for this breeding. Embryo transfer using Chin Chin semen is only permitted on the following condition. Should the Chin Chin semen provide more than 1 foal, an additional stud fee of \$ 4,935.00 plus G.S.T. is due immediately to VDL Stud. Registration of the foals will be restricted through the registries to 1 foal per \$ 4,935.00 plus G.S.T. paid.

The frozen semen has been tested in Holland and is EVA negative.

- Frozen Semen must be shipped in a liquid nitrogen dry shipper at the Buyers expense. The shipment should be planned at a minimum of 2 weeks prior to when you plan to breed your mare. Customers may provide their own dry shipper or contact Prima Equestrian regarding rental of a dry shipper.
- No frozen semen will be shipped until all fees are paid in full. If necessary to speed up the payment verification process, Prima Equestrian can take a certified check or money order. Orders placed on our website shopping cart, using PayPal (which uses credit cards) will be charged an additional 3% on top of the stud fee.
- You will need to arrange for liquid nitrogen storage for your semen when it arrives. If you do not have a liquid nitrogen storage tank of your own, often your vet will have one or know of one. You should ask if they charge you for storage of the semen. You must transfer the semen immediately from the dry shipper into a liquid nitrogen storage tank. Failure to transfer the semen within 24 hours of receipt will void this contract and may have jeopardized the integrity and quality of the frozen semen. Prima Equestrian and VDL Stud are not responsible for the frozen semen once it has been shipped. Insurance is recommended on each shipment, this can be arranged with Federal Express at time of shipping.
- The shipment will be sealed with a plastic tie wrap. The Buyer should insure that this tie wrap has not been broken and that the dry shipper is frosty when first opened to transfer the frozen semen. The frozen semen should not be held out of the tank for more than 8 seconds or the frozen semen could be damaged. If the shipment did not arrive sealed and cold, the Buyer should make a claim to Federal Express within 24 hours or the insurance is invalid. It is the buyers responsibility to check the semen when it arrives, file a claim with Federal Express should it have been damaged in shipment and transfer the semen the same day to a permanent storage facility.
- We recommend that you breed within 4-6 hours post ovulation. The closer you get to ovulation, the better your chance is to getting your mare in foal. Post ovulation ensures that you do not have to use more than 1 dose per heat cycle. Prima Equestrian suggests that your veterinarian do a breeding soundness exam on your mare before you decide to breed your mare. A culture and biopsy should be done prior to breeding to insure that the mare is clean and is in good condition for breeding. This will save you money by taking these tests and ultimately reduce your veterinarian and semen costs. Your breeding veterinarian can advise you the best.

Switching to Fresh Semen with Navarone or Farrington (Option):

If you use 3 breeding doses on 3 different heat cycles on the one Mare identified in this contract and still do not get your mare in foal, you may switch to using fresh

semen and the live foal guarantee using Navarone or Farrington standing at Majestic Gaits. Please see Fresh Semen Backup Contract for details.

FEES - Frozen Semen:

Stud Fee: VDL Stallion Chin Chin Frozen Semen \$ 4,935.00 plus G.S.T. You can also send a cheque, certified cheque or money order made out to Prima Equestrian. Payments made on our web site shopping cart using Paypal (which uses credit cards) will be charged an additional 3% on top of the stud fee.
